DEAR READER

Saving resources plays an important role within Austrian tourism. Environmentally friendly energy comes from hydropower plants or photovoltaic systems in many places. "Biodiesel" (hydrogenated vegetable oil) is often used for snow groomers. Investments in ski areas focus on replacing existing lifts with new ones.

The sentiment within the hotel industry is good. New openings include Harry's Home in Salzburg and Moxy Vienna City East in Vienna. The Falkensteiner Hotel & Spa Carinzia in Carinthia has renovated all rooms and extended its offering to include Family Suites. Hotel Gasthof Hirschen in Schwarzenberg in Vorarlberg is converting some of its rooms into spacious apartments. With the refurbished Podenhaus, a historical jewel has reopened in Bad Aussee in Styria. Unique: the PhiloPop-Up Hostel in former Gasthof Risserhof in Scharnitz in Tirol.

There are various offers that invite guests to explore nature away from the slopes. Excursions in the Hohe Tauern and Gesäuse national parks enable participants to discover the starlit sky.

Winter swimmers can look forward to a new offer at Lake Fuschl in SalzburgerLand, where there will be supervised cold water swimming once a week. And those who prefer icy rock faces will find new ice climbing routes in the Paznaun Valley in Tirol.

A "super cultural year" is coming to Upper Austria, where the Salzkammergut will become European Capital of Culture in 2024. The province will also be celebrating the 200th birthday of composer Anton Bruckner with various events. Other highlights for those interested in culture are the newly opened Anton Lehmden Museum in Deutschkreutz in Burgenland and the new Prater Museum in Vienna, which will open in spring 2024.

We also introduce you to some extraordinary personalities. These include fish expert Martin Müller from Carinthia, Christmas decoration collector Franziska Winder from Upper Austria, Austria's youngest five-toque chef Benjamin Parth from Tirol and violinist and new director of the alpenarte orchestra Matthias Honeck from Vorarlberg.

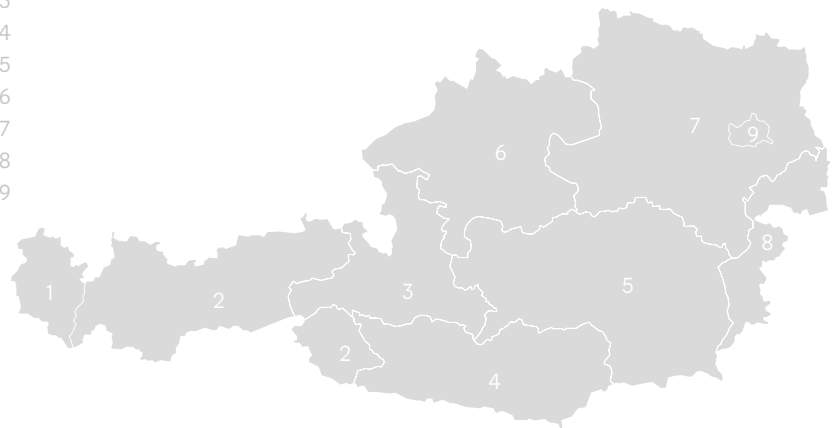

CARINTHIA

Practice area for ski tourers

How do you go about ski touring safely? Aspiring ski tourers can obtain the relevant know-how along the 5.2 km educational trail in Innerkrems, which is equipped with information boards. From winter 2023/24, an avalanche training field will extend the area, with newcomers able to try out their LVS device (avalanche transceiver) before they begin the tour. Innerkrems ski school offers supervised avalanche training once a week.

Gerlitzen: smartphone becomes a ski pass

From winter 2023/24, skiers will have a particularly comfortable time on the Gerlitzen. They will be able to load their ski pass onto their smartphone, regardless of whether it's a day ticket or season pass. The innovative solution also helps the environment, saving on thousands of disposable tickets and keycards. The resort of Gerlitzen is located at an altitude of around 2,000 m with guaranteed snow. It boasts 20 lifts and 32 km of slopes.

The XCX Skills Park opened on the Steyersberger Schwaig in the Vienna Alps last winter. The practice area for cross-country skiers of all ages is located near Kirchberg am Wechsel, directly on the Wechsel Panorama Trail. From this winter a new footpath will lead to the XCX Skills Park, meaning that spectators will also be able to reach the area more easily. A shuttle bus runs from Gloggnitz and Aspang train stations every Saturday and Sundays as required. Adults who would like to try cross-country skiing can get the right equipment in Kirchberg am Wechsel. Rental equipment for children is available directly on the Steyersberger Schwaig.

Tickets with added value in the Hochficht ski area

The Hochficht ski area includes nine lifts and 20 km of slopes. It is located in the Bohemian Forest, where Austria, Germany and the Czech Republic meet. Keen skiers will be able to enjoy added value from winter 2023/24, with all lift tickets being valid from 3 pm the day before and therefore also valid for night skiing. A 1 km long slope is floodlit from 4 to 7 pm on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Last winter, a new 10-person gondola went into operation in the Grebenzen ski area in the Murtal. The lift company is investing again for this winter and creating a new 2 km long blue slope. This increases the total km of slopes in the family-friendly ski area to 27. From the coming season it will also be possible to whizz down the slopes on ScoopJets. The modern toboggans, also known as speed carvers, take riders down to the valley through simple weight shift.

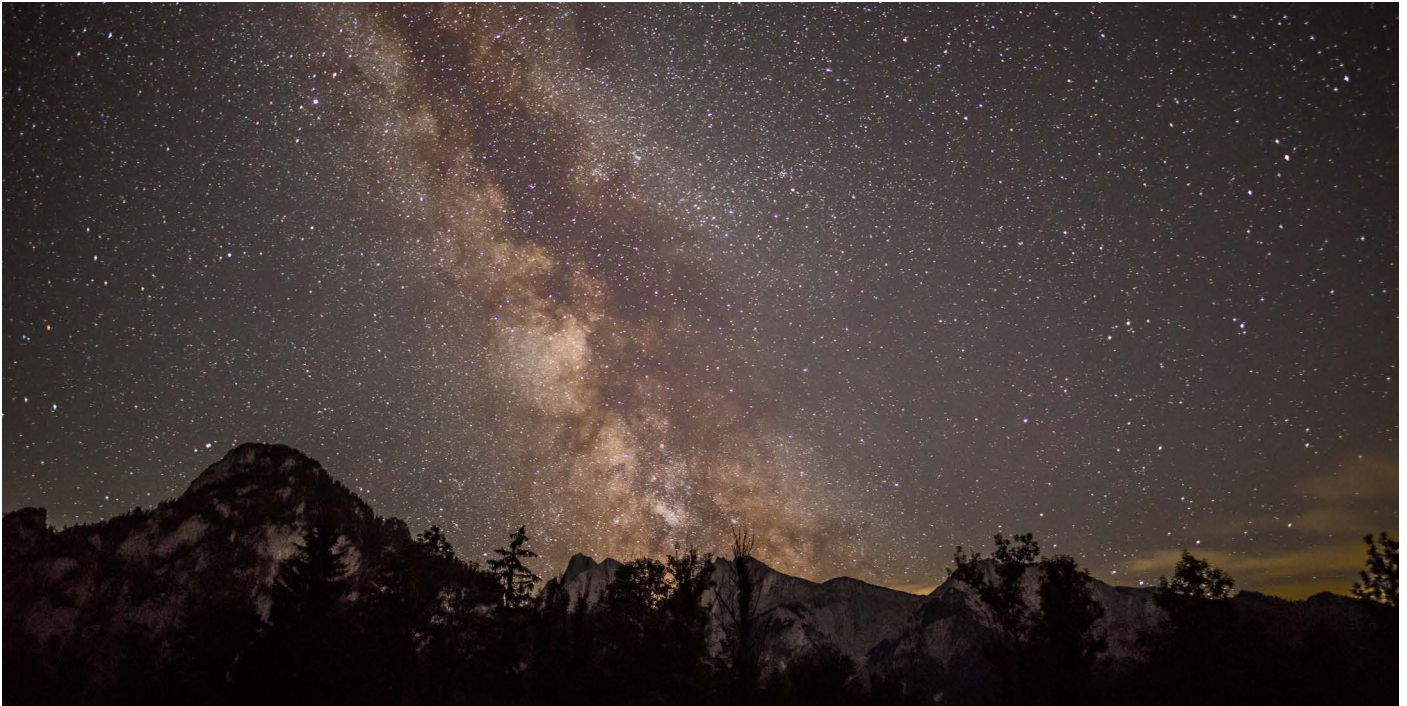

CARINTHIA

Starry sky tour in Hohe Tauern National Park

Hohe Tauern National Park, which stretches across the provinces of SalzburgerLand, Tirol and Carinthia, is one of the darkest places in Europe. Starting this winter, rangers will lead a starlit tour through the Carinthian part of the national park. Participants experience the darkness in the mountains with all their senses, learn more about the importance of the dark for wild animals and get to see constellations with the naked eye. Tours set off from the Sadnighaus in the national park community of Mörtschach. They take place on 13th December 2023, 10th January 2024, 7th February 2024 and 6th March 2024 and last around three hours. The actual walking time is about an hour. Those interested can register on the national park website from mid-November.

Scenic snowshoe hike to the Saualpe

Various offers invite you to experience "Magic Moments" amidst nature on certain dates in Carinthia. A new addition in winter 2023/24 is a snowshoe hike to one of the Saualpe peaks. Beautiful views far across the province can be enjoyed from the easily reached mountain range. The tour to the 1,896 m Großer Sauofen begins at the rustic Steinerhütte high above the Görtschitztal. From there the snowshoe hikers leisurely trudge uphill to the summit. Once at the top, the group enjoys tea and coffee before hiking back to the starting point.

Through snow-covered pine forests

Guided tours within unique natural spaces promise "Magic Moments" amidst nature on certain dates in Carinthia. New to the 2023/24 winter programme is a snowshoe tour through the UNESCO Biosphere Reserve Nockberge. Accompanied by a ranger and equipped with lanterns, participants hike from Ebene Reichenau to picturesque St. Lorenzen at dusk. This is not only the oldest settlement in the area, but also home to Carinthia's highest parish church. The path leads through the moor and snow-covered pine forests to the idyllic church of St. Anna, where the hikers can recharge their batteries with a hot drink and traditional "Bettlerkrapfen" doughnuts. In the light of the lanterns the tour then returns to the starting point.

Cross-border hiking in Thayatal National Park

The new suspension bridge in Thayatal National Park paves the way for an impressive winter hike. Since April 2023, the bridge near Hardegg has led over the Thaya into Podyjí National Park in the Czech Republic. It takes around two and a half hours to complete the 6 km cross-border circuit, starting from Hardegg National Park House. The trail leads to two beautiful vantage points with views of the Thayatal and the "Einsiedler" (hermit), a high rock face with a visible cave in which a hermit is said to have lived. New wooden loungers invite you to take a break along the way. These loungers have been positioned in particularly beautiful spots along hiking trails since summer 2023.

Guided winter hike in Thayatal National Park

A new guided hike around the Umlaufberg has been added to Thayatal National Park's winter programme. The mountain rises on the border of Austria to the Czech Republic and is the landmark of the cross-border protected area. There are particularly lovely views of the winding river landscape when the trees are bare in winter. The guided hike begins at the Kaja castle ruins and takes around four hours. The first date is set for 28th December 2023 with further dates planned for the following winter months.

In Schwarzenberg am Böhmerwald there will be a new signposted snowshoe tour from winter 2023/24 that is particularly suitable for families. The tour starts and ends at Gasthaus Dreiländereck where you can also reward yourself with a bite to eat after your winter adventure. Winter bathing and stand-up paddling at Lake Fuschl

Bathing in cold water makes you healthier and happier. As of winter 2023/2024, Lake Fuschl will be inviting you to brave the cold as part of a group. From December to March you can try winter bathing at the Fuschlseebad every Thursday from 4:30 pm. Experienced cold water swimmers are on hand to give guidance and there is tea to warm up afterwards. Participation is free. Another refreshing new offer coming to the winter lakes of the region is stand-up paddling. Participants head out onto the water wearing a wetsuit and warm boots for the approximately 2-hour tour accompanied by certified SUP instructors.

First biathlon hotel in the Alps

Hotel Neubergerhof in Filzmoos is an ideal base for cross-country skiers and biathletes. As the first biathlon hotel in the Alps, the Neubergerhof scores with a perfect training area right on its doorstep. Manfred Nagl looks after the guests. He was a professional cross-country skier for 20 years and is currently the coach of the national police squad in the disciplines of cross-country skiing and biathlon. Biathlon and cross-country skiing equipment can be hired at the hotel and guests can also make use of a lockable ski and service room as well as cross-country skiing maps.

Mobile observatory at Gesäuse National Park

Gesäuse National Park extends in the north of Styria. Thanks to its location far away from large cities, nights there are particularly dark and therefore ideal for viewing the starlit sky. From the beginning of 2024, the mobile observatory will make it possible to take a fresh look at the stars. The sophisticated, innovative construction with a dome and telescope is attached to a car trailer and travels to spots where the night sky can be seen from its most stunning side. The national park website will provide information on stargazing dates in winter 2024 from late autumn.

Look far across the province from the new tower

The lookout tower on top of the Demmerkogel in the Sausal was destroyed by a fire in 2019. The new "Horst am Demmerkogel", built primarily of wood, will open in mid-October 2023. Visitors can reach the viewing platform at a height of 20 m via six single-flight wooden staircases inside the tower. From the top the view extends far across the Sausal and surrounding area to Hungary, Slovenia and Carinthia. The simple structure is also intended to provide a habitat for birds, insects, bats and falcons. Four oversized sculptures will be erected around the tower: a stag beetle, a butterfly, a green lizard and a hoopoe.

Reutte on Ice

From 17th November 2023 to 25th February 2024, the Reuttener Untermarkt park area will be transformed into a dazzling dream. On an ice surface of 2,080 m² there will be skateways, space for ice dancers, curling lanes and an ice hockey area. Come evening, a special lighting concept will create a magical atmosphere. The Christmas Market will be grouped around the ice surface on two weekends in Advent. The opening on 17th November 2023 will be celebrated in style with highlights including a performance by DJ Ötzi.

New ice climbing routes in the Paznaun Valley

The Paznaun Valley is not only considered a versatile climbing area in summer. Numerous icy rock faces offer unique opportunities for experienced ice climbers in the cold season and four waterfalls can now also be climbed. The waterfalls named José, Fernando, Alfredo and Ladylike are around 50 m high each. Difficulty levels range from WI3 to WI5. WI stands for "water ice" and gives climbers information on steepness, ice quality and the difficulty of placing protection on the route.

Birds of prey and owls at National Park House Matrei

A new special exhibition is dedicated to birds of prey and owls at National Park House Matrei in East Tirol. It provides insights into the protection of the species by Hohe Tauern National Park and, above all, presents birds that live here in the largest protected area in Central Europe. These include pygmy owls, boreal owls, golden eagles and bearded vultures. Visitors also learn more about lesser-known species such as griffons, black vultures and hawks. After Arminio Rothstein's death, Vorarlberg puppeteer and cabaret artist Christian Mair managed to acquire his puppets. In 2022 Christian set up a small puppet workshop with an exhibition in Bludenz. And in October 2023 Christian and his puppets will move to a much larger building in the centre of Bludenz. In addition to the expanded exhibition and workshop, there will be a stage for live performances and a Habakkuk Café.

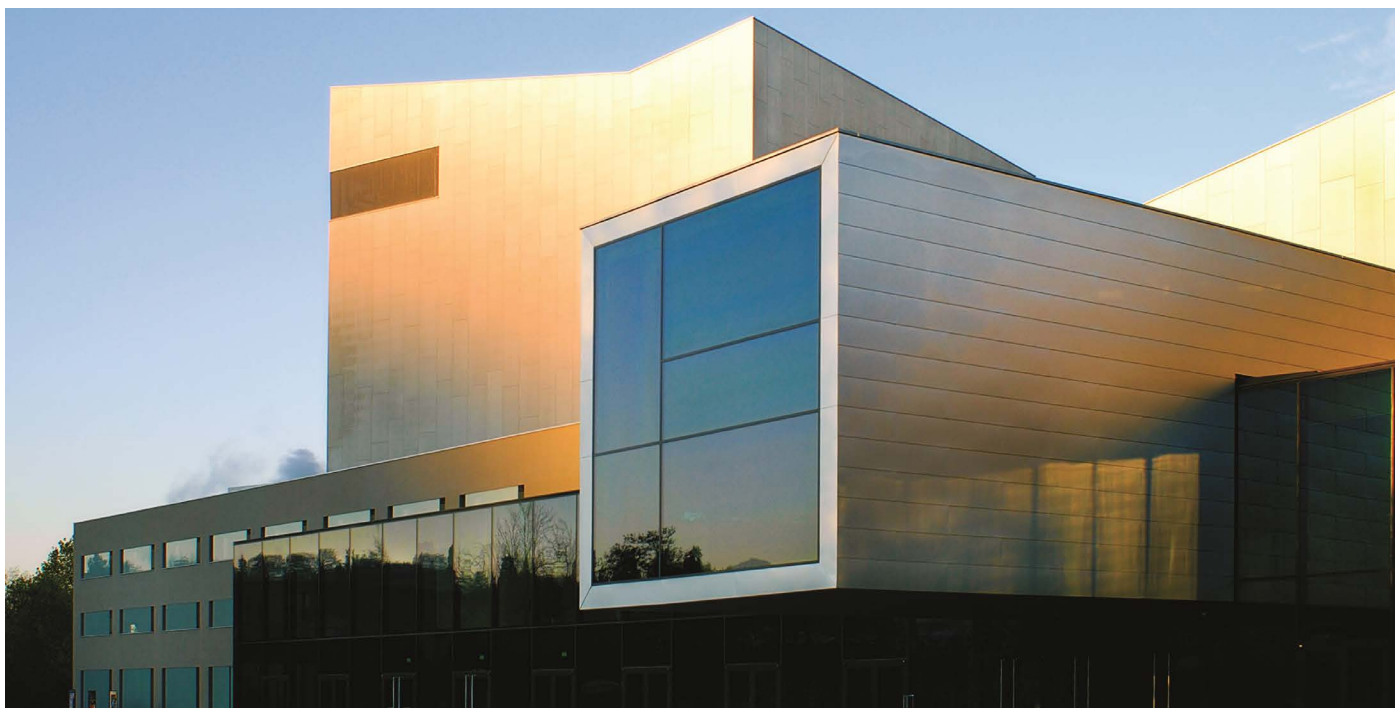

Anton Lehmden Museum in Deutschkreutz

Anton Lehmden (1929 – 2018) is one of Austria's most important painters. He was a co-founder of the "Vienna School of Fantastic Realism" and a professor at the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna for many years. In the 1960s he bought Deutschkreutz Castle in Burgenland and gradually restored the magnificent four-winged building from the renaissance period. In May 2023 his daughter Barbara opened the Anton Lehmden private museum on site. Visitors can enjoy "living art" across the 800 m² exhibition space, which features paintings, huge murals and stained glass windows by the artist. It also provides insights into the artistic design of the interiors. The Anton Lehmden Museum can be visited as part of guided tours on certain dates. Individual appointments are possible for groups of five or more.

Here he brews three different beers using energy from the in-house biomass plant: Shilling Hell, Shilling Granat and Shilling Nock Ale. Uli offers guided tours and tastings for small groups where you can try the award-winning beers such as "Gartenrast", accompanied by regional and international dishes.

Dairyman and mountain farmer Michael Kerschbaumerr

Michael Kerschbaumer originally wanted to work in education, but over time he developed the desire to get into organic farming. And because you can achieve more together than alone, he came up with the idea of founding a cooperative. This is how the organic cheese dairy "Kaslab'n" was created in 2015. The cooperative was initially formed by four farms, but in the meantime 20 farmers deliver their organically certified hay milk to Kaslab'n in Radenthein by Lake Millstätter See. From spring to autumn, their cows and goats graze on the meadows and alpine pastures of the Nockberge. In winter they eat hay. Because for the Kaslab'n producers one thing is certain: the best cheese can only be made from the best organic hay milk. The range includes around 22 varieties such as Emmental, hay flower cheese, semi-hard cheeses, and goat's cheese. Visitors are welcome in the modern dairy during regular opening hours.
